taken and injured

Now therefore know ye, that I John V. Edg-
Ordinary of said County, by virtue of the power
in me vested by the General Assembly have
granted unto the said J. W. Brown J. S. Whitty
and J. R. Whitty full power by the tenor of these
presents to collect and gather up all and singular
the goods and chattels right and credits of the
said deceased and to keep the same without
impediment or obstacle until legal admi-
nistration shall be granted and render a just
and true account of the same when thereunto
required
