until the ordinary Term of said Court of
Ordinary to call & take care of said Business
from and after the real and personal estate of the
said John M. Witherspoon in Trust of the Law to the
use Benefit and Support of those who have a right
thereunto and you the said W. A. Witherspoon will
take into your hands and possession and keep
safe preserve protect all the Goods and Chattels rights
and credits of the said John M. Witherspoon
deceased until due and legal Administration
can be had and that you do make or cause to be
made a true and correct Inventory of all
and singular the Goods and Chattels rights
and credits of the said John M. Witherspoon and the same
to make your return into my office on or
before the first Monday in January Next and
that I do hereby constitute and appoint you
the said W. A. Witherspoon Administrator for
himself and his heirs and assigns
this the 13th day of November 1815
