

Testament of Guardianship,
Georgia Douglas County.

By the Honorable the Ordinary of
said County.

To Samuel W. James, Guardian
thereof, and Maria, & James O'Flann
of the said James deceased, is possessed,
its her own right of said deceased
estate by means whereof the
power of granting the Guardianship
of said O'Flann to me is man-
ifestly known to belong and for
the better securing the estate of
said and granting a testimony
and confidence reposed in you
I do hereby commit the Guardian-
ship of the said O'Flann to
you the said Samuel W. James
your assent thereto by the ac-
ceptance of these letters, herein
charging you that you maintain
and that you enquire into and
take charge of her Estate both
real and personal and all other
things to which by law you ought
to do for your said ward.
I have and perfect account of
all which you shall render to the
Court of Ordinaries of said County
on the first term in every year
during your continuance in
office. And I do hereby consti-
tute and appoint you the said
Samuel W. James Guardian of
the said O'Flann during her minor-
ity.
