I, ----- Wm. F. Prewett of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make, declare and publish, this my last will and testament, thereby revoking and annulling any and all other wills or testamentary disposition that I may have previously made of my goods and property.

ITEM ONE.

I desire that my body be buried in a Christian-like manner in Cemetery at Ephesus Church; that the casket containing the same be placed in a steel vault; and that a suitable monument, the cost to be left to the discretion of my executrix hereinafter nominated, be erected at my grave. I also desire that my wife be buried by my side at the same place and that the casket containing her body be likewise placed in a steel vault and a monument be erected at her grave. In other words it is my desire that the body of both myself and my wife be placed in steel vaults, and a reasonably nice monument be erected at our graves.

ITEM TWO.

I desire and direct that all my just debts, including expenses of last illness and funeral expenses, be, by my executrix hereinafter nominated, paid without unnecessary delay; and that personal property be used for the payment of the same, provided however, should there not be a sufficiency of the personal property to pay the same and erect the monument provided for in item one of this will and to make provision for the burial of my wife and the erection of a monument at her grave as therein provided, then the parties that are to receive my real estate to each bear one-third part of said expense, and upon failure of either of said parties to bear said one-third, then that my executrix, or her successor in trust, sell a sufficient amount of the real estate devolved to said party as refusing, to pay said one third, and all expenses of said sale.

ITEM THREE.

All the rest and residue of my personal property, after the payment of all debts as provided in said item two of this will, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Mrs. G.A. Prewett, to be hers absolutely.

ITEM FOUR.

I give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Mrs. G.A. Prewett to have and to hold for and during her natural life, the rents and profits therefrom to be hers absolutely, all of my real estate, consisting of approximately 353 acres in land lots seventy-two (72) and seventy-three (73) of the second (11) district, fifth (5) section of Douglas County, Georgia. It is my express desire that all of the rents and profits of said real estate be for the benefit and for support and maintenance of
