certainty of death do make and execute
with my own hand this my last will
and Testament hereby making void
all former wills and Testaments here-
before made by me.

Therefore I give and Bequeath to my beloved
two Grand Daughters Annie Burston
Barr and Clara Burston Barr
children of E. Barr and my deceased
Daughter Clara Barr my two dwelling
houses and lots in the City of Bowling
Green and being on what I call East
Monticello Street leading from Bowling
to Monticello there being another Street
leading from one to the other
one of said lots is on the

Said Street and is where I dwell on Monday
of years the other lot is on the East Side of
Said Street and is where I now live to be
equally divided between my said son
Grand Daughters equal in value

Item Second I hereby appoint my son in law
E. P. Barr Guardian for my said son
Grand Daughters to Rent and the same
described property from year to year
until they become of age or marry and
during that the keep the places in repair and
and have the houses insured from
year to year and pay all annual
taxes that may accrue on said property
and that the remainder of the proceeds
arising from the Rents of said
property be applied to the support and
maintenance of my said Grand Daughters

Item Third When my said Grand Daughters become
of age or marry it is my will that they
take possession of the said property
and dispose of it as they may think
proper

Item Fourth Should one of my said Grand Daughters
die before attaining the age of twenty
one years or marriage then I wish
the Surviving one to have and own
the entire interest the decedent one
had in said property

Item Fifth In the event that both of my said
Grand Daughters should die before
attaining age or marriage then and
in that event it is my will that my
said son in law E. P. Barr own and
use the said two houses and lots
above described for and during his
natural life

Item Sixth As the death of the said E. P. Barr is in my mind
I desire that the same and his share of the
on the East Side of said East Peachtree Street
become the property of my said son in law
and that my name and lot above described
on the West Side of said street shall become
the property of my said son in law and
shall both to dispose of as they may
think proper

Item Seventh After my just debts and funeral expenses
are paid it is my will that my said son
in law E. P. Barr have the whole and my
I may have or have at the time of my
death and that he also have my
household and kitchen furniture

Item Eighth I hereby nominate and appoint my said
son in law E. P. Barr Executor of this my
last will and Testament and make
no appointment of my sole
