Item 3rd

I desire that when my land is sold that
the proceeds be divided share and share alike
between my wife and all my children. My
male Scott is to be sold. I give the Gun-
and cord to my wife Amanda, I give 600
to Preston. I give the walnut bedstead
and bedding to my wife Amanda. I desire
the personal property not yet mentioned
be divided equally between my wife and
children without going to law about it,
including everything in house and out of
doors. I give as a year support to
