I am first

It is my will that my funeral expenses shall cost, not exceeding twenty five dollars, provided, I can be buried decently by the expenditure of that amount of money.

I am 2nd

I give, bequeath & devise to my wife Rebecca C. Wright, all of my property of every kind and character whatsoever, be it real or personal, free from all charge or limitation whatever, except my burial expenses as aforesaid, in due first to her own proper use, benefit & behoof, for and during her natural life or widowhood.

I am third

After the death or marriage, of my wife the said Rebecca C., it is my will and desire that all my property given, bequeathed & devised to her, the said Rebecca C., shall be equally divided between my children L. C. Wright, & M. Wright & Margaret L. Franklin, one third to each of them, the said L. C., & M. & Margaret L.; that is one third to each after paying burial expenses of my wife, the said Rebecca C., in the sum she should die without contracting a second marriage.

I am fourth

It is my will and desire that my son L. C. Wright shall execute this my last will & testament & I hereby appoint him my Executor, as aforesaid, to execute same: and for his said services it is my will and desire, that he shall hold out of my estate, before said estate is divided as provided for in Item third, Two hundred dollars as a salary, instead of the regular

commissions as provided by law for Executors
