Buchanan during his natural life.

My Will is, after the death of my Father, that the
property aforesaid should descend to his nearest rela-
tion living in the United States of America.
I nominate & appoint Solomon Gray, Son aforesaid
& Joseph Lane my executors of this my last
will & testament, bearing date this 9th October
1824. Signed sealed &
