5th My next youngest son John Cameron
I have given him two Acres of land and a house and
other property and privilege which I am entitled to with
either of the above being all I was entitled to for him
of my estate

6th It is my will and desire that Martha
and her children Mary Martha be paid for her share
the privilege to choose her Master James she will
select one that will pay a fair valuation for her
her son John Black after all my stock of horses cattle
sheep and pigs that I may be provided for to be paid
all debts that may be due me collected, and the way that
may be in hand at the time of my decease paid and
after paying &c. my just debts the balance to be equal
divided between my two eldest sons James and
William Bamonde in addition to what I have given
them heretofore, and I further make one cousin
John Nath Cameron Bamonde and William
Bamonde my Executors to act as they may think

best in accordance with the will and I
 do hereby declare this to be my last will and
 Testament according as follows in Witness whereof
 I the said William Chambers have hereunto set
 my hand and seal the 23rd twenty second day of
 April one thousand eight hundred and fifty
