I, Clara Hannah Peck being of lawful age disposing
 mind, and knowing the uncertainty of life, and the
 necessities must hereby make, cannot and make will
 all other and former wills in whole, in part, in part;

I here write that a marriage contract was made and
 entered into prior to my matrimony with my present
 husband William Lewis Peck, which said contract in
 stipulation and condition was the power to dispose of all my
 own property by will, and that said and of said and contract
 is of full force and effect, and is recorded in the Clerk's
 Office of the County of Jasper and State above written.

I will and direct that all my said debts be paid.

I will and bequeath my Homestead consisting of my
 house (in which I now reside) and a tract of land con-
 taining twenty (20) acres more or less within the corporate
 limits of the City of Livingston Newton County being with
 beloved daughters Volcanus Francis Peck and Clara
 Lewis Peck equally share and share alike. Said
 Homestead and land to remain in the possession, con-
 trol and enjoyment of my present husband and then
 Lewis Peck for and during his natural life.

I should either of the above said Volcanus Francis Peck
 or Clara Lewis Peck in either child or child's
 heirs of their bodies, the survivors of them and heirs
 thereof inherit the whole of the said property Homestead
 and Land; and should both the above said Volcanus
 Francis and Clara Lewis die childless, the whole estate
 and remainder thereof will and be inherited by my
 well beloved son John William Hawkins.
