 Thirdly I give and bequeath and devise unto my brother William & Cook  
 all of my household and kitchen furniture and all of my stock  
 both Cows and Hogs for and during his natural life except my  
 bed and bedclothes then I desire to be divided among my whole  
 brother and sister who are now living equally

Fourthly I give and bequeath and devise unto my brother William &  
 Cook a certain promissory note which I hold on my brother  
 Reuben Cook for the sum of nine hundred dollars for and  
 during his natural life he can use the same to purchase a  
 piece of land or keep it on interest as he may choose as I  
 desire what I have bequeathed unto him forever live on during  
 his natural life time and then to be divided among my whole  
 brother and sister or their children to wit

 Cook one share my brother Reuben Cook one share my sister  
 Lucy Berry deceased her children one share my brother James Cook one  
 share my sister Diana Dally one share my sister Mary Melton
