 the same at any time provided or by deed or
 deed at her death or the way thereof proper
 all without reserve or limitation.

Fourth-

I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved
 wife Nancy, Executors and my worthy friends
 John W. Thompson Executors of this my last
 will and testament - the 12th day of May 1877
