Item 2nd It is my desire that all my just debts be
paid as soon as can be conveniently and that a
certain place of my land known as the Pitts place be
only advantage the usual length of time and then
sold for the purpose of paying my debts also that all
surplus stock such as is not entirely necessary for the
use of my family be sold likewise.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my daughter Jane
Elizabeth one bed and bedding.

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my daughter Melissa
one bed and bedding.

Item 5th I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah all
my lands except the before mentioned Pitts land and
a negro woman by the name of Harriet all my
stock as far as necessary for the support of my family during
her natural life or widowhood.

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my six sons (to wit
Timothy Joseph C. Churchhill Benjamin C. Marshall and
Daniel W. Granade all my lands stock and a negro
woman by the name of Harriet at the expiration of the
widowhood of my wife Sarah Granade.

Further I make constitute and appoint
my son John W. Granade and my wife Sarah to be
Executors of this my last Will and Testament
hereby revoking all former Wills by me made.
