 hereinafter named and appointed

Item 3rd It is my Will after my death that
 all my property of whatever kind

remain on the place just as though I were in life without any loss or disparagement and to so remain until one year after the death of my wife & child & Legat

Item 4th I will to my son John M. Legat all my lands to be and cultivate free of any rent as though it were his own during my wife's lifetime and one year after her death in order that he may support my wife and my daughter Mary having my place as a home and my farm to be cultivated and cultivated by my son John M. Legat for the support of his mother and sister Mary.

Item 5th At my will that one year after my wife's death all my property of whatever kind be sold to the highest bidder and that each one of my children have an equal portion of my estate.

Item 6th I hereby constitute and appoint my son John M. Legat Executor of this my Last Will and Testament this October 29th 1856.
