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I, John B. Turner of the State and County
memory - but knowing that it is appointed unto all men to die - and
believing it a duty to dispose of what is appointed unto all men to die - and
me with in this life, in a manner best suited to my own convictions
of right and duty do make this my last will and testament, hereby
revoking and annulling all other wills heretofore made,

Item first I desire that my body receive decent christian
burial without display or unnecessary expense -

Item second I desire my executors hereinafter named and appointed
to pay any debts that I may leave unpaid as early as possible

Item third It is my will - that my Executors here transfer
of the Stock which I own in the Georgia Rail Road and Bank-
ing Company to them as trustees for my grand daughter - her
share being Forty Shares - but it is my will that the said stock
be not transferred until my said grand daughter arrives at
full age or marries - and then the said Executors and trustees are
to pay over to her the dividend accruing on said Rail Road Stock,
as they accrue - but the dividends accruing before my said
grand daughter shall arrive at age or marry shall be part of
my Estate and not vest in said trustees for the use of my said
grand daughter. If my said grand daughter shall live to
have children then the said Stock shall be so far as the dividends
go for her use during her life and to be divided among her
children at her death - but if she my grand daughter shall
die before she arrives at full age or shall die leaving no
children, the said Georgia Rail Road Stock is to revert to
my Estate and be distributed among my children and their
representatives.

Item fourth, It is my will - that the lands that I have heretofore
given verbally to my Sons Anderson J. Turner, James H. Turner
and John B. Turner, and which lands they are now in possession
of, or have sold, as is the case with James H. Turner, be theirs
and I hereby confirm said gifts to them and their heirs, and
this Item is to be construed as a special legacy to them my
three sons -

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Signed Sealed and acknowledged
as a Codicil to the last will and testament
of Green B. Turner, who signed the same in our
presence, and we in this presence, and each in
the presence of each other.
