 Satisfied and reassured of at my death my stock of
 all kinds household and kitchen furniture
 ready money notes or accounts and all and
 every thing that I am in possession of or
 that I have any right or title or or to at my
 death to the legally devised between my best
 said daughter Martha C. Beaman and
 Mary J. Hamby share and share alike

Item Third I hereby constitute and appoint my
