Item 1st I give and devise to my beloved wife Eliza my negro woman Esther two feather beds beautiful & fine two two new such as she may choose out of my whole stock of cattle one horse named Kelly one large pine table one large trunk and one low pine chest and one linen one cupboard one half dozen chairs I have wash pot I set five hogs I dinner pot 2 ovens 1 skillet and one tin kettle I set painter plates two tables one pine saw set 1 cart and young yoke of oxen also what farming utensils she may choose to carry on the farm also the Swainsboro lot of land containing two hundred 24 acres known & distinguished more especially by the no one hundred & eighty one in the eleventh district originally Henry now Newton County also 2 acres & 1/2 perches land as she may choose out of my stock of hogs also all the gas that is in my paper 2 water pots 2 water piggins 1 milk shaver all the working iron & glassware that is in my paper also 6 gun shup such as she may choose out of my stock of shup also 1 set silver spoons all of which she is to have and hold in her own right and for her use and among her natural life or widowhood and in the event of her marriage the property to be given I have and will that it then become the property of my children
