Item 5th I make no provision herein for my daughter Eliza Woraze for the reasons that I have in my opinion amply advanced to her. Therefore she is not to have any share of my estate.

Item 6th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Skelton an equal share of my estate and at her death if she

 Item 7th I give and bequeath the share of my estate to my
 daughter Harriet Henderson and to the heirs of her body.

Item 8th I give and bequeath an equal share of my estate to
 my daughter Mary Ann Child and to the heirs of her body.

Item 9th I give and bequeath an equal share of my estate to
 my son Robert M. Henderson.

Item 10th I give and bequeath an equal share of my estate
 to my son William Henderson.

Item 11th Having full faith and confidence in my
 son Richard Henderson I do hereby appoint and ordain
 him Executor to this my last will and Testament.
