First I desire and direct that all my
 just debts be paid without delay
 by my Executor hereinafter named
 and appointed

Second I give bequeath and devise to my
 Beloved nephew Thomas A. Perry all
 The Real Estate that I am possessed
 of known as the old Perry place
 at being the same whereon I now
 reside containing Seven hundred
 acres more or less adjoining lands

on the date of said Perry's death make
 South by East of Northwards and
 about 100 feet By the hands of the
 said Saml. Marsh and Saml.
 Lewis on the 24th day of the month
 of June 1851 and said Perry at
 being all the land devised to my
 by my father with all the right
 thereof and appointment to said
 land of land in any wise being
 give power all change or limitation
 whatever in his own proper use
 benefit and relief forever with
 full power to dispose of the same by will or
 otherwise as he may deem proper
 I also give and convey to my
 beloved nephew Thomas A. Perry of
 the same unincumbered manner. The
 farming utensils belonging to my
 farm in the aforementioned purchase
 and all my stock of every description
 that I now have and all my
 household and kitchen furniture
 also all my papered walls account
 debt bonds shares in action and
 all other kindred of debts all
 without limitation or reserve
