 devise that all that we have of any kind
 of property real or personal money or
 evidence of debt shall after the death
 of either of us become the individual property
 of the survivor individually for and during
 the life of such survivor to be managed
 and controlled by her as she may wish
 without accountability to any person and
 no inventory or appraisement shall be
 made of any part or portion of the
 said property so long as either of us
 may live both of us hereby giving to the

Survivor as executor and administrator
 to the effect after the death of the survivor
 first day
 Then Third Also our joint and several interest with each
 of us in the property real or personal
 of which the survivor of us may be possessed
 We jointly and Separately Will and bequest as
 follows
 First We and each of us do give and bequest
 after the death of the survivor of us all our real
 and other household and kitchen furniture to our
 niece Margaret Ann Smith Daughter of our
 Brother Lewis Smith
 Secondly Whatever share of property or money
