 carry out what are known by my said Wife
 to be my wishes in regard to the said day
 Marrow; All this I most cheerfully commit
 to the sound discretion of my beloved Wife

Item third I give and bequeath to my beloved
 Wife Nancy the sum of all my property
 to be real and personal of whatever kind
 or character of which I may be possessed

Item fourth I desire and request that my be-
 loved Wife shall be free her death by
 will or otherwise out of the property which
 she may have, make a fund of said sum-
 -and moneys, to be placed in the hands
 of some fit and proper person after

her death, as Counsel for the said day Marrow the
 intent of which said sum may be by said Counsel
 applied to the said day Marrow of the said day Marrow
 as he may think proper

Item fifth I hereby nominate and appoint my be-
 -ed Wife Nancy the sum of all my property
 my last Will and Testament with full power
 and authority to sell and convey any portion of my
 property in such manner as she may think best
 for the interest and support
