Item first I give, bequeath and devise to my father Leonard H Livingston in trust all my personal and real estate that I may be possessed of, or in any way entitled to at my death to be disposed of and controlled by him as follows: first I desire said trustee (L. H. Livingston) to pay all my just debts as soon after my death as practical. My real estate I wish to remain intact under his control and by him rented or cultivated and from the rents or profits arising from said real estate my wife Carrie is to be supported, the same being paid over to her by said L. H. Livingston as she may require or need it, during her widowhood and at her marriage she then to share and share alike with my brothers and sisters in all my property both real and personal and I hereby require said L. H. Livingston at the marriage of my wife if she should marry after my death to divide equally between my wife and my brothers and sisters all my property then in his hands.

Item Second It is my will and desire that my father also take control of my insurance claim on the North Western Mutual Life Insurance company, the policy in said company being for two thousand dollars and collect the same and deposit in Bank the said amount and collect and pay over to my wife Carrie as long as she remains single after my death the interest on the same as part support in addition to rents or profits arising from my other property and in the event she should mar-

after my death then to divide as my other
property as herein before mentioned to be
divided. The two thousand dollars in bank
equally between her my wife and my
brothers and sisters.

L. W. Livingston Executor of this my last
will and testament.
