or go to law that him it to be deprived of any
share or interest & their share is to be equally
divided between the remainder of the here

Item 3rd

I will & leave it that my Executor collect all of my
outstanding debt as early as possible & after paying
the expenses the remainder be equally divided
between the here named in the first item

Item 4th

I will & leave it that my Executor sell out my estate
both real & personal, either public or private as
he in his judgment may think to be the best
interest of the Estate & at such time as he may
think to be to the best interest of the estate

Item 5th

I hereby constitute & appoint my worthy friend Samuel
J. Chisnut my Executor of this my last will & testament
he within whereof I the said Mary & Elloyd to this
my will consisting of this one sheet of paper have
set my hand and seal this 25 day of December 1887.
