perfect health of body and mind and memory
and desiring to make the mortality of my body
I recommend my soul to God who gave it and
my body to the dust to be buried in a
decent manner at the discretion of my relations
It also hath pleased God to bless me with the owner-
ship of property I have that will to distribute
it at my death among my relations

Section 1st I Bequeath unto my Wife Fdread ten
dollars three years after my death

Section 2nd I Bequeath unto my daughter
Agnes May three years after my death

Section 3rd I Bequeath unto Son H. Charles
Mc Donald ten dollars three years after my
death with all my tools

Section 4th I Bequeath unto my son Jas. Melvin
Mc Donald the one hundred and twenty five
dollars that I had to pay Rice as security
for him

Section 5th I Bequeath unto my son Melton
Mc Donald ten dollars 3 years after my death

Section 6th I Bequeath unto my son Robert
Mc Donald ten dollars three years after my death

Section 7th I Bequeath unto my daughter Lucinda
Mc Donald now Minnie ten dollars five years after
my death of the mares Eliza May and I she was
not then and in that case my will is for her to

and first written in three years after my death

Section 3^d of Bequest with my daughter Mary
Bequest's body here after her mother's death
my share of the estate to be divided into three shares
of equal to my share the principal sum of money of
\$1000 due to her after (1840) these and her
two children here and I share & share with her
increase the same being must not be held or
supposed of to be no other person persons whatsoever.

Section 4th There is also due to her and her
by two dollars in an estate notes due to her
Thomas in the same account that he the said John
to be made with before her to receive the same being
in the his possession. The said Thomas all my
note and all my other and with it pay all my just
debts and the rest of my left to be divided among
my heirs equally.

I have here distributed all my property among
my heirs according to my will except such as is to
pay debts. I do hereby make and ordain my willmen
James McDonald, J. C. Cook and my son-in-law
John Henderson Executors of this my last will
and testament, and I do hereby bequeath unto
and do execute all and every other former will and
testament or bequest or legacy and everything by me
heretofore made ratifying and confirming the same
my last will and testament. By witness my own
hand and the seal of the testator here to this my
will written on me this 4th of April 1839 my hand
and seal this the fourth day of January in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
thirty nine.
