C. Anderson I give my interest in the
lands owned by me and James Delaney
in the State of Florida being the lands
bought from George Suddeth

Item 3. It is my will that if my said Grand
Children Keaton and Carter should
be taken away from me or from
my wife that thereby they shall lose
their interest in and under my will

Item 4. It is my will that after the death
of my wife my said son Branham
shall not a Christian come in his
discretion sell all my property both

the same as follows I desire that

five hundred dollars to be disposed
of she pleases I give also to my

Item 6. I will that my son Branham
do spend that hundred dollars
for the support and education of
my grand children David and

Sammy Children of my daughter Harriet
Johnson

Item 7. It is my will and desire that of the
should not be sufficient income from my
estate to meet the requests made for the
support and education of my grand
children hereinafter mentioned, to wit
Neddon DeLoe Delancey David & Sammy
then my son Branham shall sell 15-2
acres of land being the south half of lot
#12 in said County being the place on
which Mrs Johnson lives and apply
the proceeds to that purpose

Item 8. It is my will and desire that after
the specific legacies hereinafter mentioned
are paid the remainder shall be
equally divided among my living
children

Item 9. It is my will and desire that
my son Branham manage and
control my estate without having to
make returns to the Ordinary or
without having to make an inven-
tory and appraisement according
to the provisions of law.
