I Item: I desire and direct, that my body be buried in
 a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances
 and condition in life. My soul I trust, shall return to rest with
 God who gave it as I hope for eternal salvation through the
 merits and atonement of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus
 Christ whose religion I have professed, and humbly trust
 enjoys

I Item: I desire and direct that all my just debts be
 paid, without delay, by my executors hereinafter appointed
 as I am unworthy my creditors should be delayed in their
 rights, especially as there is no need for delay

I Item: I give, bequeath, and direct to my beloved Wife Olive
 with whom I have lived in the strictest quietness and love for
 many years, all the land and houses on the east side of Yellow
 river at the home plantation, and I desire and direct my
 executors or administrators to superintend and have well cul-
 tivated this land mentioned for her use, and that she be sup-
 ported and maintained respectably and honorably during her
 whole life, and at her death, the lands on the east side of
 Yellow river, the houses and all the property attached to
 this plantation be equally divided between four of
 my children To wit: Augustus H Lee, William J Lee,
 Morison P Lee, and Susan Katharine my youngest daughter

I Item: I desire and direct, that twelve hundred and
 thirty dollars to be deducted from my estate to be appro-
 priated as shall be hereafter directed, and the remaining
 portion be equally divided between four of my children
 to wit Augustus H Lee, William J Lee, Morison P Lee
 and Susan Katharine my youngest daughter

I Item I give, bequeath and direct to my son Augustus

8th Item: I give one fourth part of all my property, my estate both real and personal except that portion set apart in the 4th Item I give, bequeath and devise to my son William P Lee one fourth part of all my property, my estate both real and personal, together with four hundred dollars of that portion set apart in the 4th Item

9th Item: I give bequeath and devise to my son William P Lee one fourth part of all my property, my estate both real and personal, together with four hundred dollars of that portion set apart in the 4th Item

10th Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Thysa both Crawford thirty dollars of that portion set apart in the 4th Item: as her share of all my property, my estate both real and real

11th Item: I give, bequeath and devise to my youngest daughter Susan Hathorne one fourth part of all my property, my estate both real and personal together with the remaining part (four hundred dollars) of the portion set apart in the 4th Item.

12th Item: I hereby constitute and appoint my three sons to wit: Augustus H. Lee, William P Lee and William P Lee Executors of this my last will and testament.
