 Item 3^d I Shadrach in addition to that I give the same James
 also I give to the same Joseph Paulam I Shadrach one other negro
 man by the name of Miltie together with other property
 And whereas heretofore I have given to my son Joseph H.
 Leung and other property I now give to my grand son Joseph
 H. Leung the estate of Joseph H. Shadrach four hundred
 dollars in cash (\$400) and whereas heretofore I have given
 to my daughter Eliza Ann Rogers one negro girl by the
 name of Ann & other property and in addition to that I
 now give her three other negroes namely Perry, Dory & Betsey
 & their increase. And whereas heretofore I have given to my
 daughter Cordelia & Michael one negro woman by the name
 of Mary and other property and in addition to that I now
 give her four hundred dollars in cash. And whereas
 heretofore I have given to my daughter Mary Paulam I Shadrach
 one negro boy by the name of Demetrius and other property
 & in addition to that I now give her two other negroes
 namely Dutton Susan. And whereas heretofore I have
 given to my son Washburn Shadrach one certain lot of land
 known as the Mt. Heat lot and one negro girl by the name
 of Mahala and other property and in addition to
 that I now give her one other negro slave by the name
 of Jack
