

Newton County In the name of God Amen

I Dorothea T. Rawson of the County and State aforesaid, well knowing that it is appointed to all to all and wishing to dispose of all my worldly effects wherewith it has pleased Almighty God to bestow on me, do make and cause to be made my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills

Item 1st My body I commit to the earth in decent Christian burial, and my soul to God who gave it, hoping for Eternal Life

Item 2nd It is my wish that all my just debts be paid as soon after my death as can be conveniently done.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto Florence Wether of my Nephew Robert Oliver Wether now deceased the sum of Four thousand dollars - that is to each of them one thousand

Item 4th I give and bequeath unto my Nephew Charles Wether in trust for the use and benefit of his infant son of which name I Wether the sum of one thousand dollars the interest of which said sum I wish applied by the said trustee to the education of the said Francis M. S. Wether in the event of the death of the said Francis M. S. Wether without children living at his death the said money with whatever interest may be have been paid out for the purpose aforesaid, to be equally divided among any brothers and sisters on his father's side, which he may have living at the time of his death - but if he die leaving neither child or children, nor sister or brother on his father's side, then the same to go to the said Charles Wether if he be then living - if he be dead the same to go to the children of the said Robert O. Wether then living share and share alike

Item 5th The rest and residue of my property, real personal or mixed of whatever character the same may be, money, evidences of debt stock or any other thing, I give and bequeath unto Mrs Francis A. Wether widow and relict of the said Robert O. Wether deceased, and her heirs.

Item 6th I hereby nominate and appoint the said Mrs Francis A. Wether to be executor to this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 19th day of September 1859
