deceased, four shares of the

I give to Sallie C. Pritchett and her
sister Hartha Rebecca Congers four
shares of the Stock of the Georgia Rail
Road and a Banking Company to
be divided between them

Item 4

I have given to Harriet D. Bowen
and her daughter Rebecca Elizabeth
Bowen six shares of the Stock of the
Atlanta & West Point Rail Road and
at death they or the survivors of them
is or are entitled to six shares of the Stock
of the Georgia Rail Road and Banking
Company.

I have given and will continue to
share with my Brother John S. Congers
what of money I may get in present
form of -

My Stock in the Augusta Factory
consisting of (1) live shares I give
to my dear niece, children of my
brother Dr. William D. Congers
decd., to wit, Emma B. Clark Elizabeth

and not as this husband.

Whatever I may have of other prop-
erty or effects, at my death, I give
to Chloe P. Herring.

I desire that William H. Clark
