tinue and Ordains this my last Will and testament (as
follows to wit)

1st I Commit my soul to God and my body to
the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner
And that all my just debts be paid out of my
effects

2nd My wife and deins is that my beloved wife
Anna A. Mann have all my effects both real and
personal under her entire Control during the natural
life and thus at her death have the right to dispose of
the following portion of Property, to whom she may
desire to give it either by will or otherwise (to wit) one
hundred acres of land off of what is called the Grand
lot also the hundred acres of the Stallings lot including
all the improvements by way of buildings, and also
all the perishable property that may be on hand at
the time of her said death

3rd My wish is at the time of the death of my
beloved wife Anna A. Mann that two hundred
acres of my land as be given to my daughter Susan
O. Haize and to her children after her death
said land to be left in the hands of my friend
Memory Edwards or to such other person as the
Court having jurisdiction may appoint and in some
to be disposed of by my said daughter's husband
Columbus Haize as her portion to wit the East
half of the lot called the Stallings lot and one hun-
dred acres known as the Hammock lot.

4th My deins is that Richard F. Coleman (col'd)
boys that are bound to me under the law, for
their faithfulness and obedience to my wife under
their Contract until they are twenty one years old
have fifty acres of land called the Gilbert place
for a compensation for their service and the two
hundred dollars to which I am bound to the Court.
