Item the 2nd It is my will that my kind & affectionate sister Francis Monack shall have and take a life time estate in all the profits of my estate real, personal, mixed including stock, excepting a fund sufficient to pay the expenses of administration & any debts I may lawfully owe.

Item 3rd It is my request that my sister Francis Monack should make my present residence in Oxford her permanent home, if however she declines to do so and prefers that my Oxford residence should be sold, by her making that fact known to my Executor, then it is my will and direction that my Executor sell the said house & lot upon which I reside, and annually pay over to my said sister Francis Monack the interest upon the sum for which the said house & lot may sell.

Item 4th It is my will that my sister Francis Monack take possession of the property conveyed to her, and which she is to use during her natural life, except however she is only to take the profits of the said real estate, the stock itself to be held for that purpose by my executor.

Item the 5th At the death of my sister Francis Monack I give and bequeath to the children of my grand daughter Rebecca Francis Payne all and singular the property & estate herein given to my sister Francis as a life estate, and the estate thence to the said Rebecca Francis Payne, ^{children} to be one in fee simple.

Item 6th I do hereby appoint my friend John A. Williamson of Newton County the Executor of this my last will & testament.
