knowing that I must shortly depart this life desire at right and proper
time of the property with which I am endowed that I should make a dispo-
sition for mine then my last will and Testament hereby writing and availing
them & I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and
Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition
in life My soul I trust I shall return to rest with God when
I give up the ghost as I hope for salvation through the merits and atonement
of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ

Item 1st I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without
delay by my Executors hereafter named and appointed

Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Samuel two Acres & below
two beds one bed did one male also one third of the lot of land
No 220 in the ninth district of originally Henry now Newton with
one third of all the rights, incidents and appurtenances to said
lot of land in any wise belonging free from all charge and
encumbrance whatever to his own proper use benefit and behoof
as he may deem proper also I give and bequeath unto my beloved
son Samuel one side house on the same unrevoked manner

Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Sidney two Acres & below
one male also one third of the lot of land named in the item above
in the same unrevoked manner

Item 4th I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Emily one chest one
table one male two Cows and Calves also one third of the lot of land
mentioned in the foregoing items in the same unrevoked manner

Item 5th I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Shrummer wife of
William Shrummer Ten dollars in money

Item 6th I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Bayly wife of George
W Bayly Ten dollars in money

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Item 11 I give and bequeath unto my daughter Julia dear love

Reason I leave ten dollars in money
Reason I leave the sum of my son Green to please

Item 12 I give and bequeath unto the heirs of my son Green to please
Foot dollars in money to be equally divided with said heirs

Item 13 The residue of my property both real and personal wheresoever
whenever it may be to be equally divided between my dear son

Samuel and Siding Johnson and my daughter Emily Johnson
with the exception of two acres of land on which my son James

Johnson now resides which I give and bequeath unto him with
all the rights members and appurtenances thereto free from all taxes

and limitation whosoever to his own profit and benefit and defend
power with full power to dispose of the same by will or otherwise

as he may deem proper
Item 14 I direct that my beloved wife Sarah Johnson be supported me
of the effects bequeathed unto my two sons Samuel and Siding

Johnson and my daughter Emily Johnson during her natural life
Item 15 I hereby constitute and appoint my son Samuel Johnson Executor of

this my last will and Testament the

Codicil

Whereas I Samuel Johnson did on the tenth day
of August in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Sixty
one sign seal and declare and publish my last will and Testament
in the presence of F. J. Womack, John McArt and Henry Anderson who
signed the said will and Testament as Witnesses and whereas I am desirous
of adding and changing a bequest and devise in the fifth article of said
will I therefore make and publish this Codicil to said will and Testament
First I revoke and annul the said fifth article of said will so far
as relates to one third of the lot of land, one chest, one table,
one mule and live hogs and calves.

Secondly I give bequeath and devise to my son Samuel & Siding Johnson one
chest and one mule I bequeath and devise unto my two sons
Samuel Johnson and Siding Johnson the lot of land on which said two
sons and calves
