 ing the uncertainty of this life and the
 absolute certainty of death and being
 desirous to settle my worldly affairs
 while I have strength so to do, make
 and publish this, my last Will and
 Testament, hereby revoking any and
 all wills by me heretofore made; and

First

I commit my soul to God who gave
 it, and my body I desire to be buried
 in a Christian-like manner in the
 family burying ground in Oxford
 Cemetery, near Oxford, Newton County

Georgia, near the last rectory place of my late husband, Stephens P. Kemmon. I do will and devise that my executor hereafter named shall pay out of my estate all my just debts of any and every kind at my death without delay.

I do hereby give my will and devise and I hereby bequeath all my property of every kind both real and personal and all my action and whosoever interest I may have and own in any property of any kind both real and personal and moved and chose in action, to my three young children to wit: Emma Cearing, Stephens Thomas Cearing, and Annie Cearing, children of my daughter Emma Cearing, wife of Wm. P. Cearing, said property whether it may be, to be divided equally between my said three children, shore and shore alike, and I specially desire that my said executor shall see to it, that no guardian for said Kemmon, Stephens Thomas and Annie Cearing should they still be minors at my death, or any of them, shall take or receive any part of their property from my estate until a bond with good sufficient and approved by said Guardian as required by law.

I hereby designate and appoint Philip V. Carbone of Madison Georgia, husband of my sister, Nellie Carbone, formerly Nellie Cuenelly, Executor to this my last Will and Testament.
