as I should have with the same if I
were living. So far as does not conflict
with the following of this my last will
and Testament

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my wife Ann
Eliza J. Brown for her sole and separate
use all my household and Kitchen furniture

Item 4th It is my will and desire that I should
my wife Ann Eliza J. Brown may
in the happiness of that sort the
all my property Real personal and
mixed (except such as I have given

to her in item 5th) Be specially divided between my wife and my children and representatives of children. Share and share alike. My wife drawing One Share and my children as Representatives of children per Legit drawing one Share each.

Item 5th It is my will that my wife's portion off to each one of my children in her or the money (sum of \$500 or more) of the sum it first) his or her part of my estate as to much as she may desire but provided she does not give more to one of my children than to another.

Item 6th I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Anna Eliza Brown, Executrix and my son Richard L. Brown and William P. Brown Executors of this my last will and Testament, directing that my Executors and Executrix perform my will after my death and have it admitted to Record and then the Court of Ordinary to have our further jurisdiction of my estate but my Executors & Executrix to have the entire Control & Management of the same without being required to make Returns to the Court of Ordinary.
