

I Richard Lloyd of County of Kent
and State of Georgia being of sound disposing mind and
memory and knowing that death will come, and wishing to
settle of my property in my own way as near the fol-
lowing as I may, but with some testament in relation thereto.

Item the first. And hereby I bear to my wife during
an natural life and afterwards all my estate both real and
personal when condition that she maintains and edu-
cates my children the maintenance to correspond with
my present circumstances and the education at the dis-
cretion of my wife.

Item the second. It is my will and desire that she should
have a set of my children. Because of age or marry during the
natural life and afterwards of my wife that then remain.
that should my said wife may appoint off property
in kind and value as she may think fit, to such
child becoming of age or marrying.

Item the third. It is my will and desire that my
wife during her natural life and afterwards to all things
to do any property of my estate or purchase other prop-
erty as she may desire.

Item the fourth. It is my will and desire that the
children should not have any jurisdiction over my estate
or the affairs and concerns of my representatives during the
natural life of my wife only so far as to allow
the will and testament to be regular power and put
upon the same.

Item the fifth. It is my will and desire that
upon the death of my wife or upon her marriage that there
be no dower and appointment of my estate and that there
be a division of my estate between myself and my children
each to share and share alike.

Item the sixth. It is my will and desire that when
my property may be set a part to my female children

under and by order of the preceding items, that is the first time
a whole property may come during her lifetime may be put
to my female children in either case the property to be given
to Lewis Baker in trust for such female child or children
and their heirs.

Item the seventh. It is my intention in the event my wife
marries that her husband shall not be appointed Guardian of
either of my children and that he shall not in any case have
the control or management of the person or property of either of
my children and that such father husband of my wife shall
not be appointed Administrator with the will annexed of
my estate or have the control thereof by any appointment
under any other name.

Item the eighth. I do hereby appoint my wife of my
to Lewis Baker and my self either Lewis Baker of
Tucker County Georgia to this my last will and testament
and I do hereby revoke all other wills or testaments.

Item the ninth. I do hereby appoint each and all of my
children of any power whatever to sell or convey any part
or portion of the estate assigned by this instrument for their
use or to such sole and separate use by the express order
of the trustee.
