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- I the undersigned of said County & State being of advanced age & knowing that I must shortly make a disposition of the property which I & my family have blessed us do therefore make this my last will & testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me
- Item 1st I desire & direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances as & condition in life
- Item 2nd I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid by my Executor hereinafter appointed as soon after my decease as possible
- Item 3rd I give to my daughter Rebecca my negro girl named Rachel
- Item 4th I give to my daughter Frances my negro girl named Blake
- Item 5th I give to my son Siler to the place whereon he now live containing one hundred & fifty acres or consisting of about forty five acres off of the land purchased of S. Dorrell all of the land purchased of Morris & Garrison and a part of the land purchased from R. L. Smith
- Item 6th I give to R. & Anderson in trust for my daughter Elizabeth Anderson the wife of the said R. & Anderson during her natural life and at her death to her children one negro woman named Lucy & her increase now in her possession
- Item 7th I give to my wife during her natural life the following described property to wit my plantation whereon I now live also the following named negroes to wit Jory a woman & her two children Georgia Ann & Sam. Sam a woman Ann a woman and her two children Tula & Jim Lucinda a woman Martha a woman Tony a man, Has a man, Davy a man, Doc a man, also all my Mule Horses Cows, Pigs, Hogs & Sheep all my plantation tools Corn fodder Cattle & provisions of every kind that I may be possessed of also all my money notes & accounts after my death
- Item 8th I give at the death of my wife to my grand son Siler R. Reynolds my negro boy Glen
- Item 9th I give at the death of my wife to my two daughters Rebecca & Frances my plantation whereon I now live
