 many then my property is to be sold and equally divided between
 my wife and my children then living.

Item Thirdly I hereby appoint my Father testamentary
 Guardian of the child I have now living or any others that
 may be born unto me.

Item Fourth I appoint John D Thompson my Father
 Executor of this my last will and testament.
