

And by any other children for amount from 1852 to 1855. After my death my executor shall collect from my married and unmarried children and from my daughter Mary & Scott and her husband David Scott the further sum of five hundred dollars being advanced on the sum of five hundred dollars advanced to them in certain bank notes on loan late to Jane Jones late the daughter of my daughter Mary & Scott. And when my estate on the 25th day of December 1852, and said executor shall charge and collect the sum of ten per cent for amount on said amount of five hundred dollars advanced to them after the 25th day of December 1852 of said amount is not paid by that time.

I do give and direct that if any of the heirs or estate shall in the future hinder or obstruct this my last will and testament my executor shall not distribute to them their share and shall collect from them if possible what may have been given them by me in person herebefore.

I hereby constitute and appoint my friend and neighbor Leavitt H. Linington executor of this my last will and testament. This February 16th 1852.
