In the name of God Amen I Richard Turner of the County of Newton and State of Georgia being of sound and disposing mind and memory and in my usual healthy condition knowing that I both here appoint and make out in my usual healthy condition to dispose of the within estate, wherewith I both please God to bless me, do make and make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills and testaments.

Item First I do the bequeath of my God given body I commit my spirit and request that my body be returned to its mother earth, in decent Christian burial.

Item Second I desire that all my just debts be paid as soon after my death as may be convenient.

Item Third I give unto my beloved Wife Mary Turner during her natural life a widowhood. I bequeath a negro man, being a negro woman and mourning a negro woman. It is further my wish and desire, that my beloved wife be provided with a comfortable home during her natural life or widowhood, by my Executors, either at the place where I now live, or at such other place as she and my Executors may think best, and in the event of a place other than the place at which I now live be selected for that purpose, I desire my Executors to sell my plantation, and out of the proceeds to purchase a comfortable home for my dear Wife, together with all necessary household and kitchen furniture, and provisions for one year and sufficient farming tools, horses, cows and hogs all to be provided by my Executors - and all to be the property of my dear wife during her natural life or widowhood.

Item Fourth I have heretofore given to my four sons (viz) James Turner, Phares Turner, Robert Turner, and Benjamin Turner each the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars.

Item Fifth I give and bequeath unto Robert H. ^{Turner} ~~Turner~~ in trust for the sole and separate use of my daughter Mary E. Causton wife of James Causton during her natural life and after her death to her children in fee simple, the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars.

Item Sixth I give and bequeath unto Benjamin B. ^{Turner} ~~Turner~~ in trust for the sole and separate use of my daughter Elizabeth W. ^{Turner} ~~Turner~~ wife of Henry B. ^{Turner} ~~Turner~~ during her natural life and after her death to her children in fee simple the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars.

Item Seventh I give and bequeath unto Robert H. ^{Turner} ~~Turner~~ in trust for the sole and separate use of my daughter Mary Ann
