 even date with this want in favor of
 my son A. H. Cowan and my two daugh-
 ters Mary L. Loyd and Annie L. Cooper;
 amount of each note is \$25.00.

After these notes and all my just debts
 are paid I desire that the children of
 my deceased daughter Laura F. White
 receive their mother's share of my estate.
 I appoint my son A. H. Cowan executor
 of this my last will and testament.
