Georgia I, William S. Lee of said
Newton County State and County, Being of
sound and disposing mind
and memory do make this my
last will and testament hereby
rescinding all others heretofore made

Item First, I desire and will that all my
debts be paid. After my death by
my executor to be hereinafter named

Item Second, Having given to all my children
with the exception of my son William
B. Lee either upon their marriage
or arrival at majority the sum of
Five Hundred Dollars, I hereby
will and direct that my executor
to be hereinafter named, before there
is any distribution of my estate pay
to my said son William B. Lee the sum
of Three Hundred Dollars as it is my
will and desire that he may said
son should be made equal with
my other children in the division
of my property

Item Third, I give bequeath and devise to my Daughter
Margaret A. Goodall formerly Margaret
A. Lee the sum of Five Dollars this being
all I desire her to have out of my estate
having already advanced to her in my
lifetime what I conceive to be her
interest in my property

Item Fourth, I give bequeath and devise to my
son Walter C. Lee the sum of Five Dollars
this being all I desire him to have out
of my estate having already advanced
to him in my lifetime what I conceive
to be his interest in my property

Item Fifth, After my death I desire and will
that my executor hereinafter to be named
should sell all my property both real
and personal and collect all the
assets of my estate and after paying
all debts owed by me and the amount
mentioned above in my will viz Five
Hundred Dollars to my son William
B. Lee and Five Dollars each to my
Daughter Margaret A. Goodall formerly
Margaret A. Lee and my son Walter C.
Lee, I will and devise that my entire
estate be equally divided among my
five children Mary, F. Lee, Julia
formerly Mary, F. Lee, John, W. Lee,
William B. Lee & Eugene C. Lee
After John, W. Lee shall have account-
ed for the sum of Four Hundred
and Twenty Nine Dollars advanced
to him in my lifetime and Julia
C. Clark formerly Julia C. Lee shall
have accounted for the sum of Three
Hundred Dollars advanced to her
in my lifetime. It is my desire and
will that they the said John, W. Lee

And further Black Gammy, Jenkins, Lee shall account to Mary, B. Lee, Gammy, Mary, B. Lee, William B. Lee & Eugene O. Lee for the amounts advanced to them so that in the distribution of my estate they shall have Mary, B. Lee, Jenkins, Black Gammy, William B. Lee & Eugene O. Lee shall each receive an equal amount of my estate

Now Let It be hereby constituted and appointed
 Son William B. Lee Executor of
 this my last will and Testament
