 make and publish this my last
 will and testament, hereby revoking
 all wills by me at any time heretofore
 made. And first I commit my soul
 to the God who gave it, and my body
 I desire to be buried in the family
 burial ground in Newton County, and
 my worldly affairs I dispose of as
 follows.

1st Elizabeth C. Scott, my daughter,
 to have one thousand dollars (\$1000.00)
 and at her death to be divided amongst
 my children ^{or their heirs} equally—

2nd That the balance of my estate be
 divided equally between my heirs—

3rd I appoint Simon T. Spur and
 F. O. Fielder my executors.

 H. Scott to this my will, consisting
 of the foregoing one sheet of paper,
 I have set my hand and seal— this
 25th day of August 1855.
