 and unmarried then I direct that all my
 property be divided share and share alike
 between my children living at that time
 If at the death of my wife my third daughter
 Maria be alive and unmarried she should be single and
 should after her death marry then I direct
 that all my property be given to the one re-
 maining for her natural life or until she shall
 marry. And I will and desire that when the
 estate herein given to my said daughters shall

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 terminate testimony their marriage as death as
 hereinbefore provided then that the whole of
 my estate be divided share and share alike
 between my children living at the time of
 such division

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 I therefore hereby constitute and appoint my wife
 Amanda C. as the executor of this
