I James Forsyth of said State And County being of a advanced age and knowing that I must shortly depart this life do give it forth And make it forth my family and my self that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me For therefore make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me

I Item I desire and direct that my body be buried in decent Christian like manner suitable to my Circumstances and Condition in life

I Item I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executors hereon after appointed as I am unwilling any creditor should be delayed in these rights

I Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sydia with whom I resided in the strictest conjugal love of said County of Paulding Georgia

one living fine black hundred and twenty and eleven hundred and eighty one the County of Paulding Georgia containing forty acres each more or less with all the rights premises and appurtenances to said lots of land in any wise belonging free from all charges and limitations whatsoever and her heirs and assigns

and I have given and will give to said Sydia the full power to dispose of this said land in any wise belonging free from all charges and limitations whatsoever and her heirs and assigns

After death by will deed as she may think proper I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife in the same unincumbered manner the farming interests used or now belonging to said plantation of Georgia containing whatever and her heirs and assigns

peaches and pines and oaks All my stock up to my head hold and the same plantation being to and used on said plantation all without reserve or limitation but quit in the same manner as I have given and bequeathed to her

I Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sydia with whom I resided in the strictest conjugal love of said County of Paulding Georgia

only my negro slave John about forty years old

I Item I have constituted and appoint my beloved wife Sydia executor and my son Elijah B. Forsyth Co. executor of this my last will and testament this 5th day of August 1858
