 after appointment and after paying my just debts

 to my daughter Hannah & Martha a feather bed and
 clothing a piece when they arrive of age

4. I give to my daughter Hannah and my daughter
 friends George W. Johnson and Edward W. Johnson
 Executors of this my last Will and Testament
 this 14th July 1856
