Item 1st I declare this to be my Last will & hereby revoke
 all wills heretofore made by me.

Item 2nd I will that my body be buried in a Christian
 decent like manner suitable to my Christianization
 Life and that my funeral expence be paid out
 of my Estate with all other just bills that I
 may owe and I direct further that my Executor
 hereinafter named to fix a suitable Protection
 and Provision of my frame and my wife Grace
 with Massey Cumblum attached I and the
 Expenses also to be paid out of my Estate before any
 division of Personal Property is made.

Item 3rd I will that my wife Sarah & Camp shall have
 all the annual profits rents of all my Real
 Estate for and during her Natural Life also she
 is to have all the Money Notes and accounts
 with all the Live stock of every description
 with Farming Tools wagons and Buggys household
 and Kitchen furniture
 including beds and bedding except the furniture in
 the western Part of the house which I will to
 my Daughter Fanny to have for her dower
 her Natural Life. Said Sarah & Camp is to
 have the whole of household and Kitchen
 furniture except the furniture mentioned in
 this Item of this my Last will.

Item 4th It is my will that at the expiration of
 my wife's Life time that my Real Estate be
 divided as follows: my Son Robert W
 Camp is to have the seventy seven (77) acres
 of Land known as the Mosch Land and
 bounded as follows, on the west by Lands of
 James M. Owen on the North by Robert Turner
 on the East by Lands of W. H. Camp and on the
 South by Lands of W. H. Camp and Co. Camp
 also eight acres of off the west side of the La.
 Camp Lands making a Total of Eighty five
 acres more or less. (John F. Camp is to have
 one half of the horse Place on the west
 side of the house. He moved from
