Item 1st Intending this to be my last will & hereby revoke
all other Wills before made by me.

Item 2nd I wish my Executor as soon as possible after my
death to pay my debt, purchasing funeral Expenses and
the Expenses in my last sickness first out of my very
Estate of my Estate

Item 3rd It is my will that if I understand my Executor
go to have the sum of one hundred dollars out of the
debt or proceeds of my Estate for his support and
that he may live during his natural life & he
should marry then he is to have no more
Interest in my Estate

Item 4th It is my will that the land belonging to me to
wit: One hundred and fifty Acres more or less lying
and being in Sevier County located in Anderson County
said title land bounded as follows on the North
by Land belonging to the Estate of J. A. Stuart dead
and Yellow River on the East by Yellow River North
by J. B. Bradford and old road and on East by
lands of W. H. L. Webb containing One hundred &
fifty Acres more or less It is further my will
that the above described Land to be divided between
my Executor Thence undivided & I understand
Thence undivided is to have the portion of the
Land described above that the dwelling house is
on and the said Thence undivided is to have
all the Household Goods including kitchen
furniture of every kind that I may leave

Item 5th It is my will that Mr. Frank Underwood is to
have no interest in any of my Estate as I have
already advanced to him as much or more than
advancing money to buy his home and therefore
he is not entitled to any more.

Item 6th It is my will that if my Children wants the Land
themselves or any one Reads the Land that the
One hundred dollars mentioned in Item 2
of this will is to go to J. P. Underwood & pay
during his natural life unless he marries
again in the event he remarries then
he is not to have the one hundred dollars
any longer
