Item 3d I will and bequeath and devise all of my Property both Real and Personal of whatever kind and wheresoever situated to my wife - Permelia Hadden to be hers during her Natural Life and at her death whatever is remaining of my Property same to be sold and the proceeds equally divided between my Children or their Offspring as the Case may be

Item 4th I hereby make my wife Permelia Hadden Executor of this will and I relieve her from making any Inventory of my Estate or Offspring or from giving any Bond and she is required only by this will to Probate the will and she is further relieved from making any return of her acts and things to any Court whatever
