I Mrs Ellen Turner of said state and county, being of sound mind and memory do make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made

Item (1) I direct that all my just debts be paid, and that a suitable tombstone be placed over my grave.

Item (2) I give and bequeath to my sister Mrs Belle Kistler, The house and lot in Bunyon Roadside County Georgia, where she now lives. I also give her all household and kitchen furniture not otherwise disposed of in this will.

Item 3 All money that I may have on hand at the time of my death I direct to be divided as follows:- One half of same to my sister Mrs Belle Kistler. One fourth of same to Mrs Lillie Waldrop and one fourth of same to Mr Charles Kistler.

Item 4 I give to my sister Mrs Emma Gibson my large pillows and direct that she select another article from my household goods that she may desire for a keepsake.

Item 5 I give to my niece Catherine Harris my gold watch, and a new Pink quilt.

Item 6 I give to Rev G M Baker his father's picture.

Item 7 I nominate and appoint Waddy McColletree as executor of this my last will and testament, and relieve him from making bond or obtaining any court orders in the execution of this will. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 26th day of July 1932.
