Item 1 I do hereby give and bequeath to the sum of One Thousand Dollars to be paid to the City of Cuyahoga, Georgia, the interest of which shall be used in keeping up the Cuyahoga Cemetery lot at Cuyahoga and Stone Mountain Georgia

Item 2 It is my wish and desire that a stone tomb and an iron fence be placed around the final lot in Stone Mountain Cemetery and that my remains be placed at the graves of my Grandfather Dr. Henry Lee, Grandmother Cynthia Lee and my two brothers Robert E. and James Henry Lee's grave

Item 3 I give and bequeath to my Aunt Matly Lee of Atlanta Georgia ~~the sum of One Thousand Dollars (this item cancelled in the original)~~

Item 4 It is my wish and desire that a memorial window be placed in the Baptist Church at Cuyahoga Georgia for my father Dr. H. Lee to cost about Five Hundred Dollars

Item 5 I give and bequeath to the Baptist Church at Cuyahoga Georgia the sum of One Hundred Dollars (this item cancelled in the original)

Item 6 After the above provisions of my will have been complied with it is my wish that the residue of my estate be equally divided between the homes for the Encouraged and the Old Ladies Home in Atlanta Ga. (The above Item 6 cancelled in the original)

Item 7 I hereby name and designate my cousin J. N. Lee Sr. of Atlanta Ga Executor of this will and my last will and Testament, Signed Sealed in Cuyahoga and declared this Eleventh day of December 1924 March 26 1925
